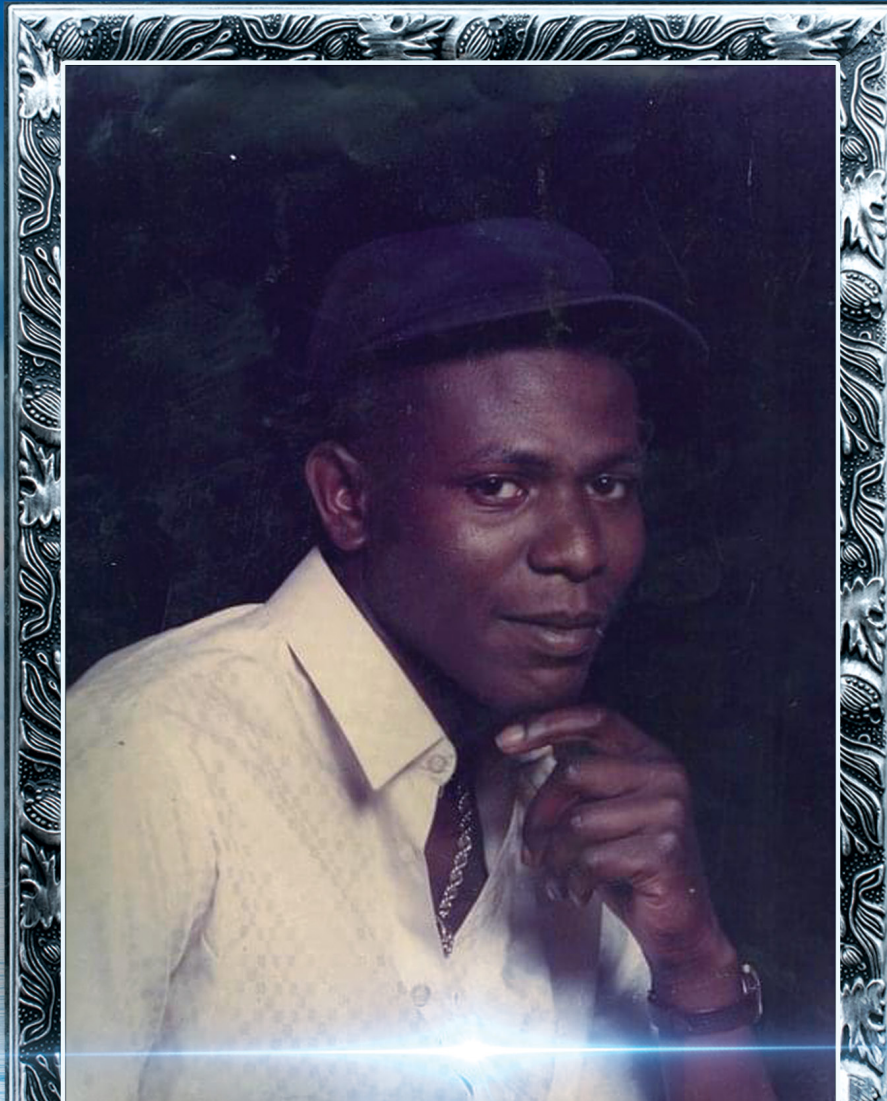

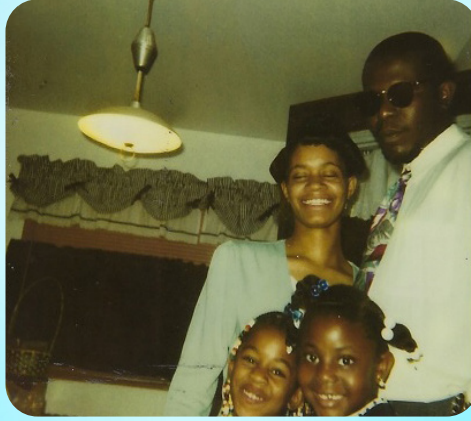

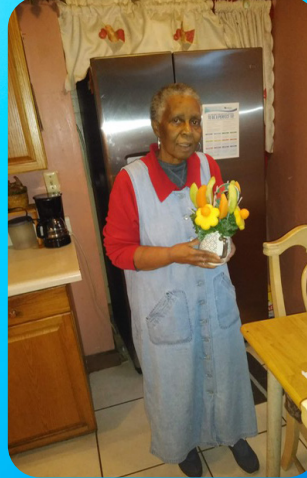
To My Loving Dad in Heaven
