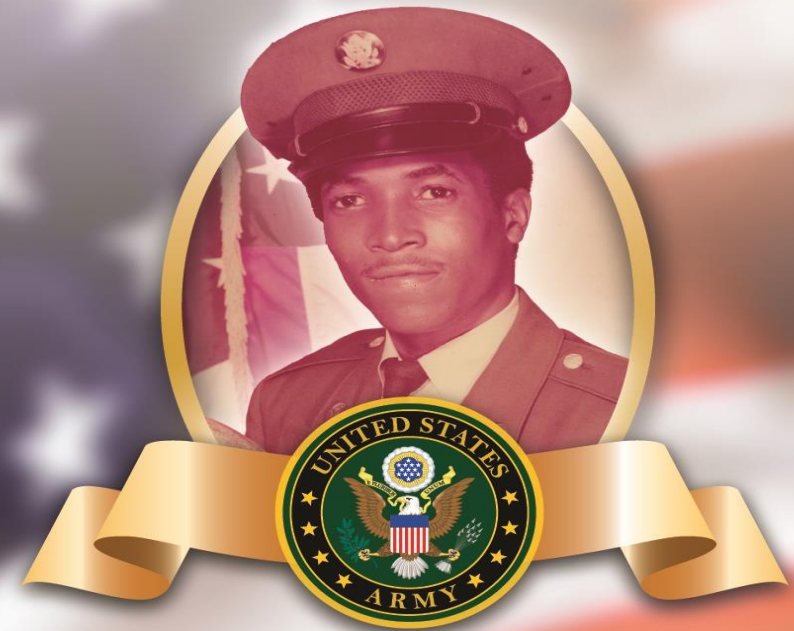

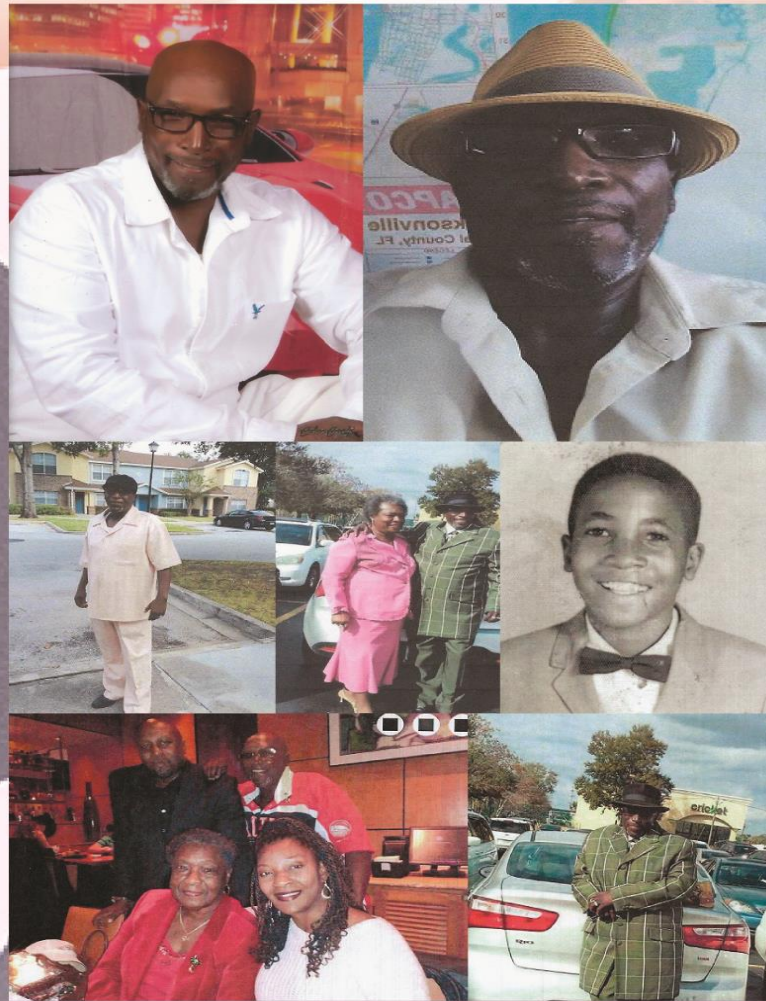
# Order of Service
