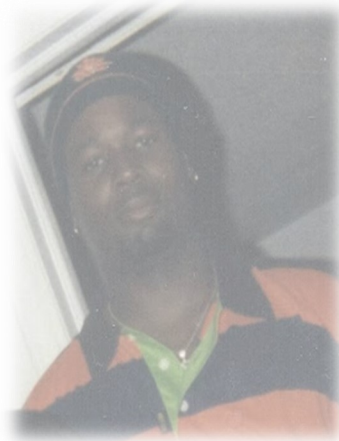
The Obituary

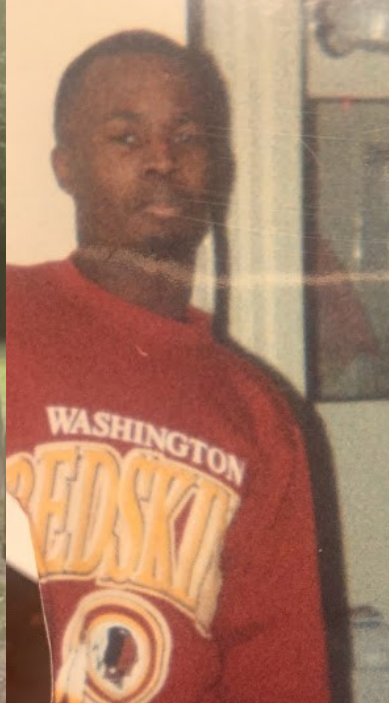
