there is no one who misses you more than me.

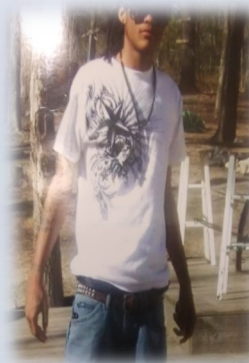
A thousand words cannot bring you back, I know, because I’ve tried.
