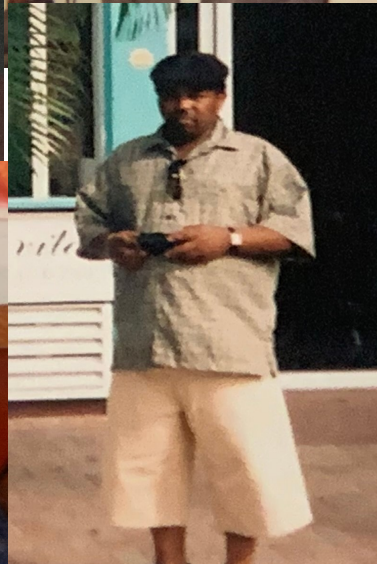
Ernest was preceded ion death by his brother, Otis Williams.
