Julius (Bubba) Dewayne Sistare, Sr. was the son of Julius (Tom) R. Sistare and the recently departed Ella Ivey Sistare. He was born on Friday, July 17, 1964 in Union County, North Carolina. He transitioned on Sunday, February 13, 2022 in Indian Trail, North Carolina at the age of 57. This was four (4) months following his Mother proudly gaining her Heavenly Wings.

In his early years, **Bubba** attended Waxhaw Elementary School in Waxhaw, North Carolina and Sun Valley High School in Monroe, North Carolina. He graduated in 1982.
