She was full of compassion and love for all, especially her family. She was the one to bring people together and spoke with everyone no matter what.

On Saturday, February 20, 2021, our beautiful flower Terry-Ann departed this life after being ill in the hospital for weeks, which has left family and friends heartbroken because she had a heart of gold that makes it so hard to say goodbye.
