

She worked diligently in the hospitality industry for several years, including at several hotels, World Insurance Services, and Bed, Bath & Beyond until her health failed.


Wanda had a love for helping those in need. She enjoyed having a good time with anyone she met. She had a gift for helping those in need. This gave her great joy.
