*For part of us went with you,*

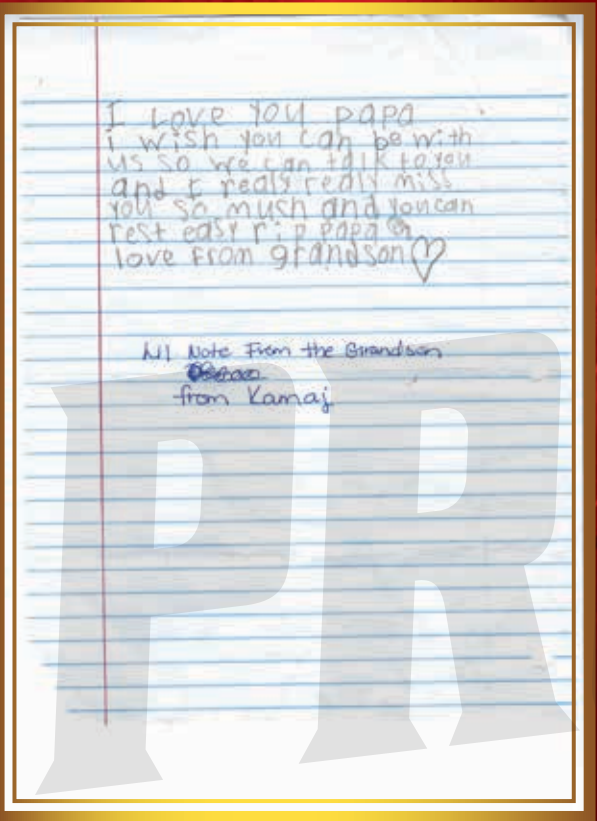
