In my heart you hold a place,

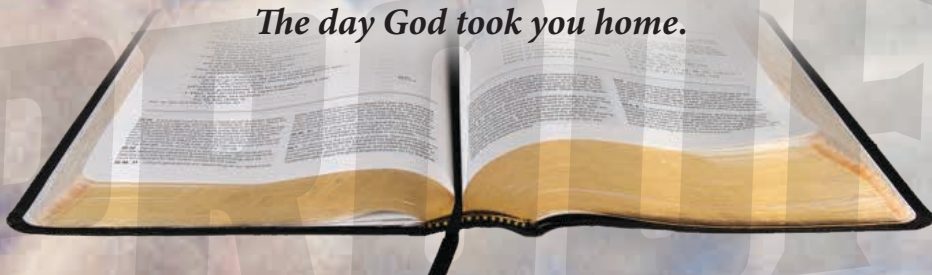
That no one could ever fill

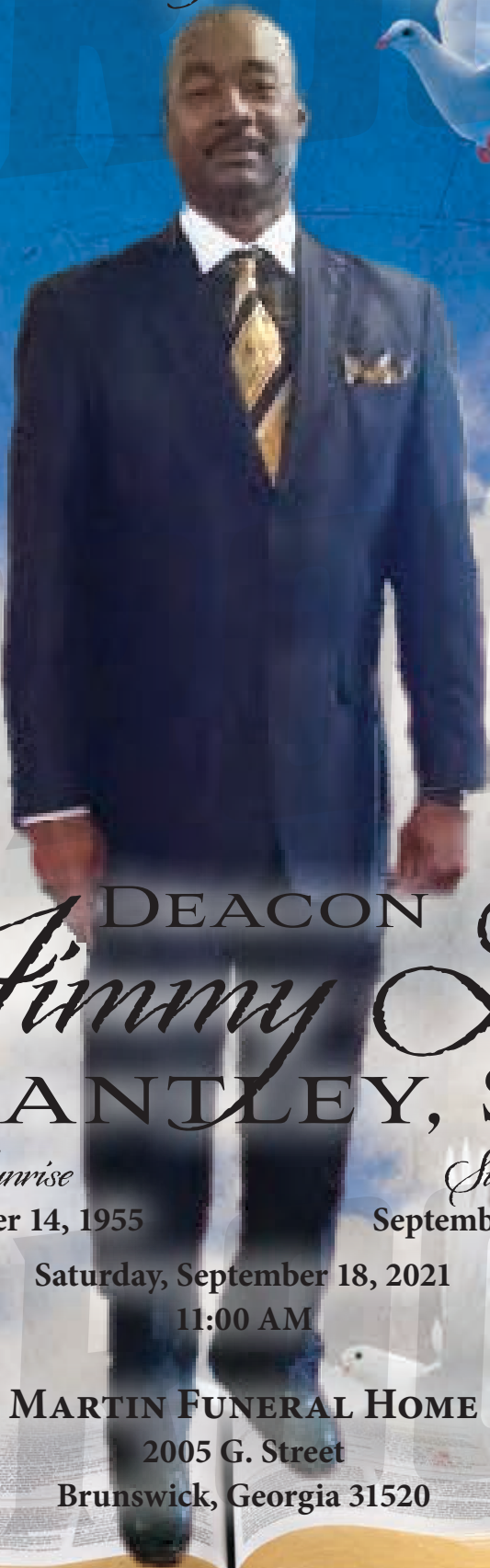

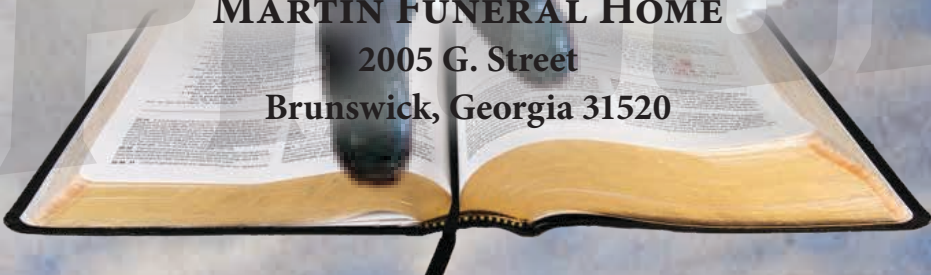
