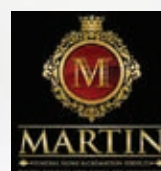

Share the happy memories we've made. Do not let them wither or fade. Sometimes our final days may be a test, so remember me when I was at my best.

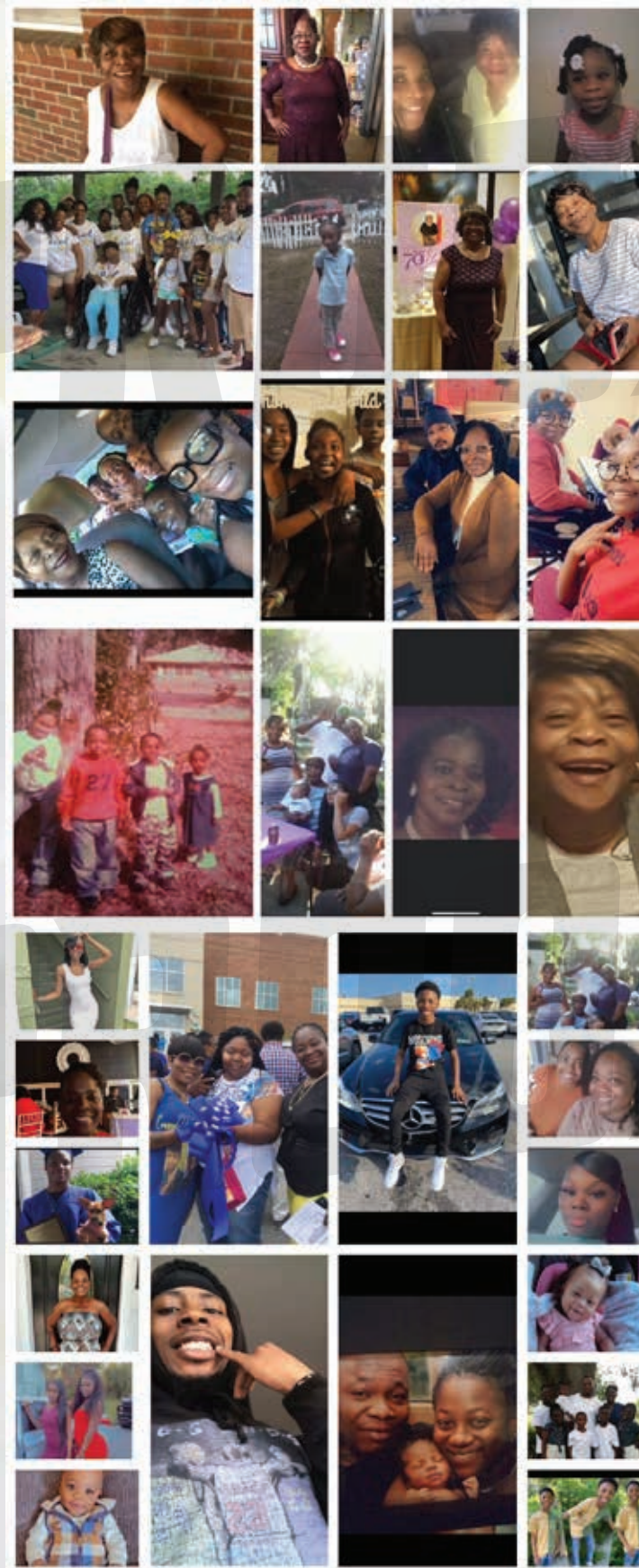
