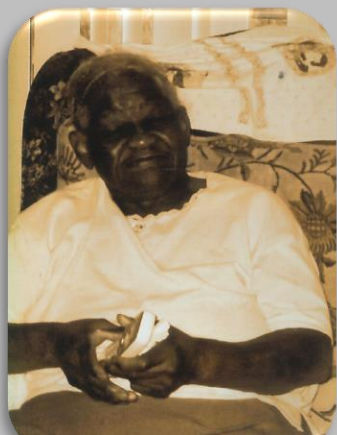
Life Reflections
