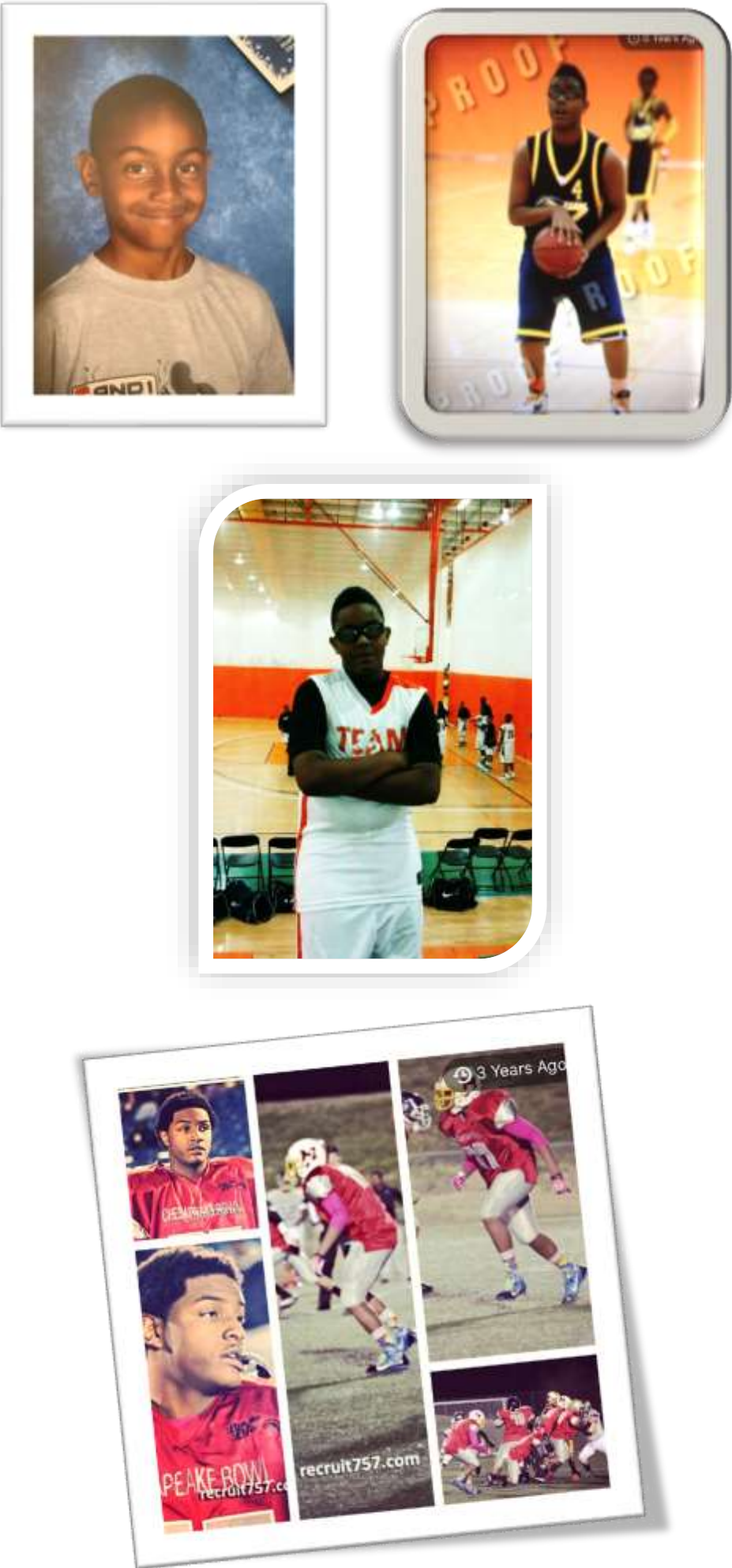
Life Reflections
