

## *Broken Chain*

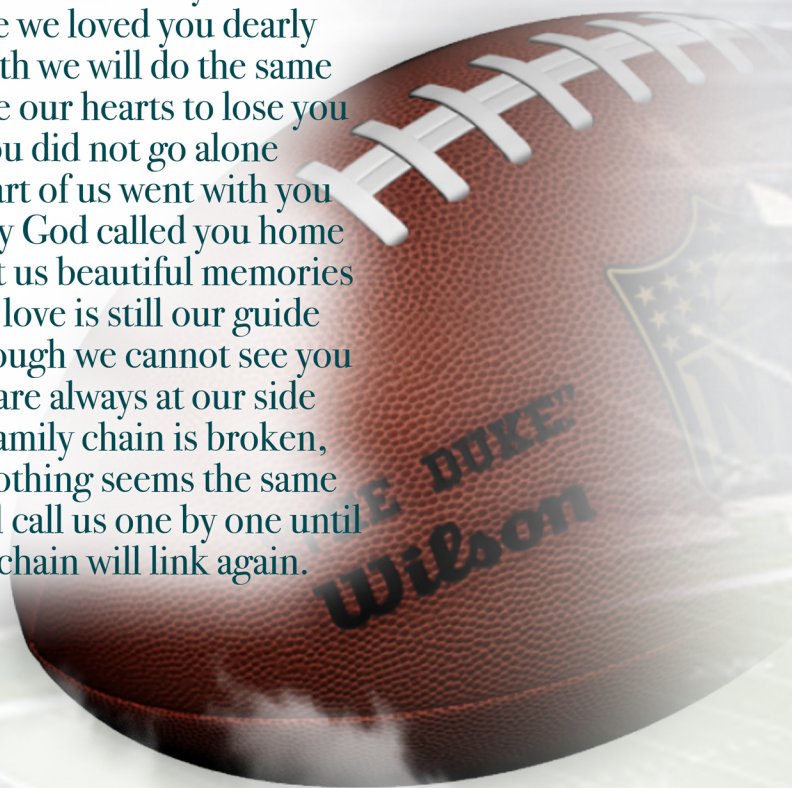
We didn't know that morning

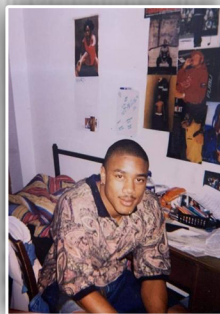
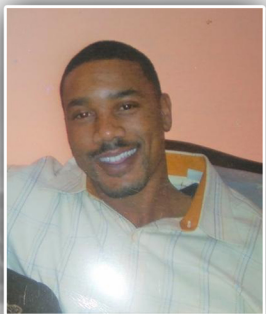


# Life Reflections
