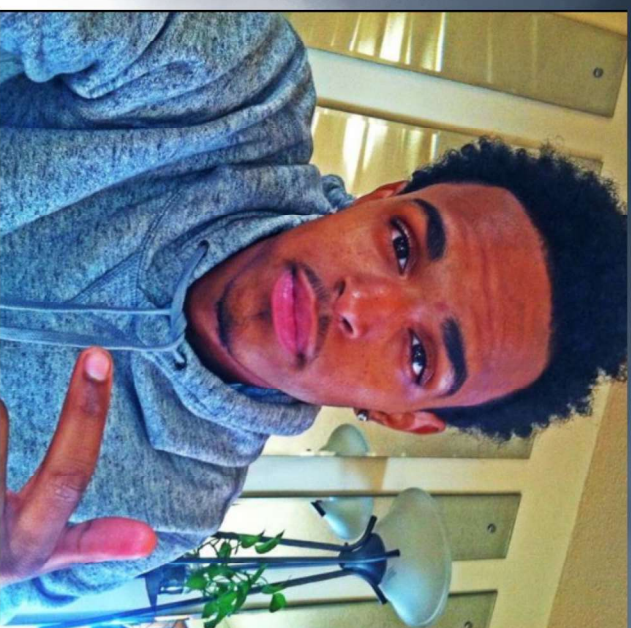

OBITUARY

Tyreem Anthony Jameson was the youngest born to Anthony and Leticia Jameson, joyously arriving on August 31, 1996, at Downstate Hospital in Brooklyn, NY.

Tyreem was baptized at Christian Faith Tabernacle Baptist Church in Brooklyn, New York.

Tyreem attended Captain Vernon A. Richard FDNV High School in Brooklyn, New York, where he played football. He graduated in 2014 with a Regents Diploma, and later attended Medgar Evers College.

Tyreem loved to travel, whether it was RVing with his cousins to Canada or road tripping with his brothers and nephew to Virginia Beach, or vacationing with friends, he loved to explore the world around him.

Tyreem developed a passion for singing after several solo performances in church in both La Porte and Brooklyn. He would go on to nurture this passion for the rest of his life. He recorded his first song in 2020, titled "Where Have You Been?", which is available on all platforms. He dreamed of having a successful singing career.

Tyreem departed this life suddenly on July 18, 2022, in New York City. He is survived by his father, Anthony Jameson, brothers Jamal (Dawn) Kennedy, Anthony Richardson, Antoine Richardson, and Darren Jameson, as well as by dozens of aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, and nephews.
