May there ne'er be another storm.

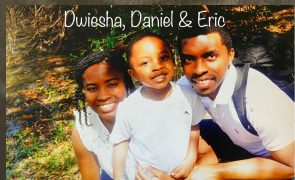
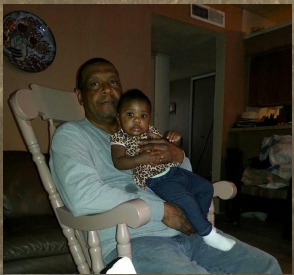
