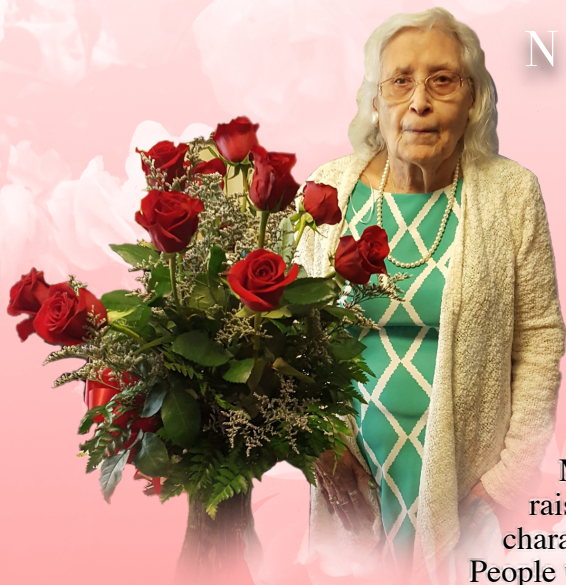

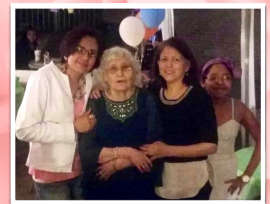
She lived in Longview, Tx from 1996 until her departure.
