at the MN Veterans Home in Fergus Falls.***

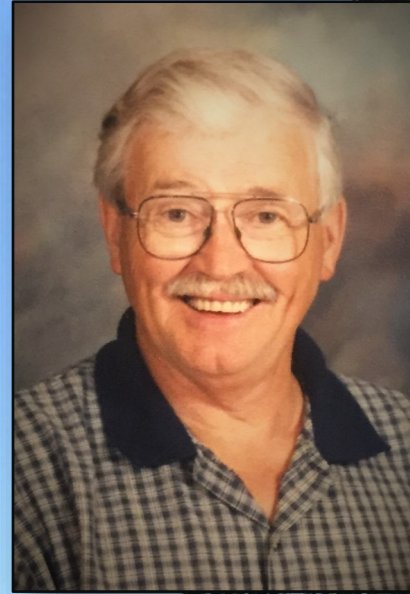

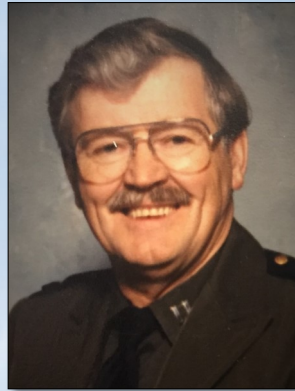
