He was born September 14, 1952 to Norman (Moose) and Dorothy Vlies.

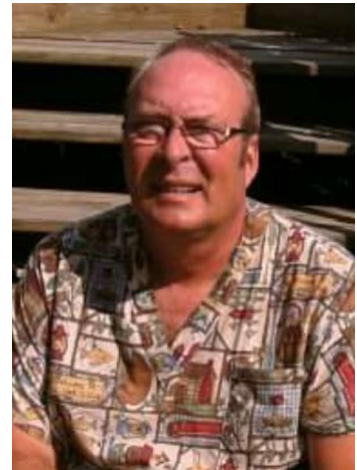
Prior to his retirement he had been employed at the Algoma Long Term Care Unit as a CNA, as well as with Home Health Care.
