**Robert (Bob) L. Baudhuin**, 63, of Slovan passed away unexpectedly at Bellin Memorial Hospital on Sunday July 2, 2017. Bob was born on June 10, 1954 in Green Bay to the late Harold and Noreen (Sisel) Baudhuin.

As these were special events and a big part of his livelihood. Bob carried on a family past-time for Mopar vehicles. *Or*, you could say Bob highly encouraged the love of Mopar and Massey, to everyone he met. Bob requested we remember him as just a "regular guy", but to those who knew him, he was so much more.

Bob felt a strong need to support the neighboring community. Bob was a member of Holy Trinity Parish, and was on the Parish Board. He was on the Board for St. Adalbert's Cemetery and former Parish Council member. He was Kewaunee County's Outstanding Young Farmer for 1989.
