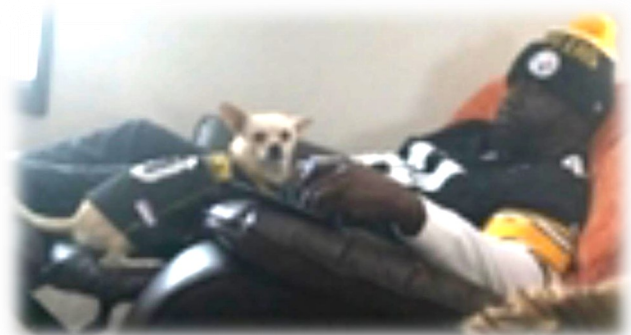




Your Spirit

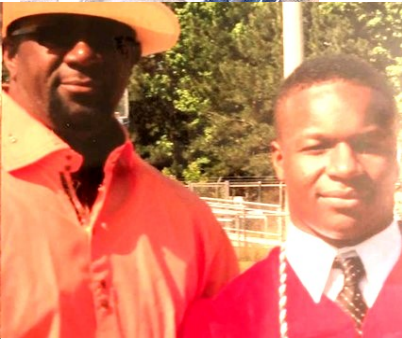
