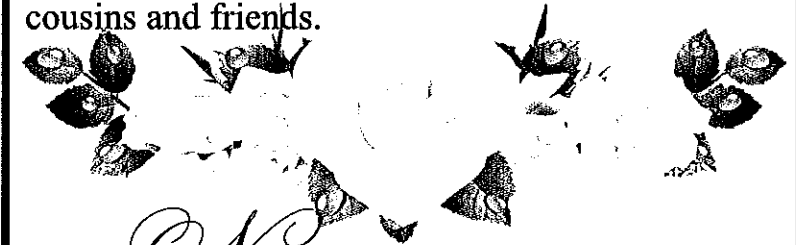
Cora later moved to Kenansville, NC. She lived a full life and was a very active member of Saint James AME Church in Kenansville, NC where she served on various boards.
