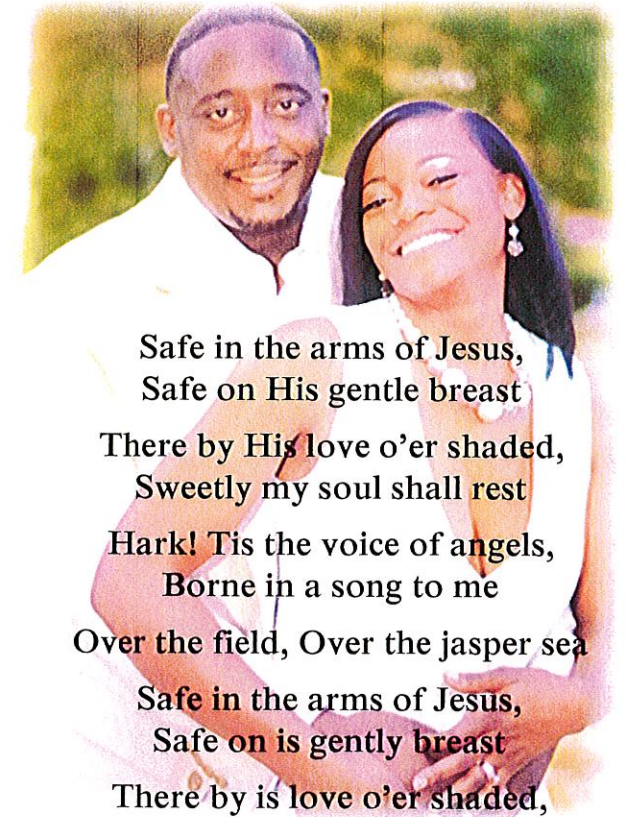
Tavallis was preceeded in death by his paternal grandmother Eula Mae Ellis and Uncle Calvin Ellis Sr.
