That an angel came and called my name and took me by the hand*

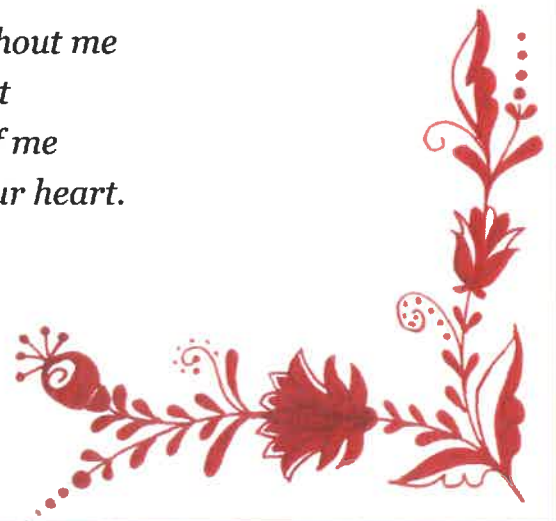
*The angel said my place was ready in heaven far above
