Obituary

Reverend Dr. Henry Daniel (Buddy) Jones, Jr., son of the late Reverend Henry Jones, Sr. and Estelle Ford Jones was born March 23, 1938 in Whiteville, North Carolina. On Saturday, August 11, 2018, Dr. Jones went down to the ticket office at Columbus Regional Health Care System, Whiteville, NC and picked up his ticket to board the Glory Train with Jesus Christ as the Conductor, bound for heaven.

Henry affectionately known as "Buddy," at an early age, joined Cherry Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Whiteville, NC where he served in various capacities. Throughout his life's journey, he frequently shared his testimony: "I got saved at an early age, but I strayed away, but early one Sunday morning something got a hold of me, and I repented, came back to the church, and made a new start." Every since that day, I have been running for the Lord, for I am going to step on that train one day, and I am going home". He has done just that. He served as a loving, devoted, and dedicated pastor of Cherry Grove Missionary Baptist Church from 1981 until his demise. He also served as pastor of Green's Chapel Missionary Baptist Church of Bolton, NC from 1986-2007. Dr. Jones served as Moderator, Vice Moderator, and an active member of the Building Committee of The Brunswick Waccamaw Missionary Baptist Association, and Past Moderator of New Era Missionary Baptist Association. He also served as the Advisor to the New Era Woman's Auxiliary, Member of the Columbus County NAACP, Member of the Ever Ready #765 Masonic Lodge, Member of the Zoning Board for the Town of Brunswick, Honorary Member of the Columbus County Baptist Deacon Brotherhood and was adopted as their pastor recently; and was affiliated with various organizations.

Dr. Jones graduated from Whiteville Negro High School, and after graduation served in the United States Army from 1955 until 1958 where he received an Honorable Discharge as a Sergeant. He later furthered his education at Southeastern Community College, and was later employed in the Maintenance Department beginning in 1962, and retired in June 2000. Dr. Jones received a Bachelor of Theology Degree from Shaw Divinity School in Raleigh, NC. He also received an Honorary Doctoral Degree from Tri-County Bible College and Seminary, Maxton, NC.

Recently, he celebrated his 80th. birthday with an elaborate, unique surprise birthday party at Cherry Grove Missionary Baptist Church, which he enjoyed very much with friends from different parts of North Carolina and other states. Dr. Jones was indeed a man who loved the Lord. He was extremely dedicated and loyal to family, friends, and the community, regardless to the time of day or night when something happened; he would be the first person to arrive, and render a helping hand.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by six siblings: James, Margie, Seymore, Maggie, Lorraine, and Janet.

He was united in Holy Matrimony to his "Sweet Heart," Ms. Reather Mae Bright for 57 years. To this union, they were blessed with two children, Vernon and Rena.
