Dorres Mary Elizabeth Shaw Baldwin, one of 10 children, was born in the Armour Community of Columbus County, October 15, 1933 to James Bennie and Emma Brown Shaw. She departed this life Saturday evening at 6:35 at the Lower Cape Fear Hospice and Life Care Center in Wilmington, North Carolina. In addition to her parents and husband, she was predeceased by seven of her siblings.

Growing up in Armour, she joined Mount Pleasant A.M.E. Zion Church at an early age.

Dorres received her education in the public schools in Columbus County and graduated from Armour High School in 1952, where she was a star basketball player. Soon after graduating, she met the love of her life, Levi Baldwin, Sr. They were united in Holy Matrimony, December 24, 1952, and moved to Springfield, MA, in their search for better employment opportunities. She worked many jobs until she was hired as a Cutter Grinder at Prat-N-Whitney (UTC) in East Hartford, CT. She retired from Prat-N-Whitney after 28 years of service.


