She was employed by the Easter Seals for over ten years as a Placement Distributor, before her health declined.

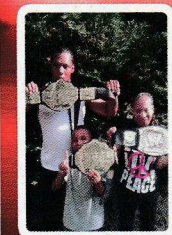
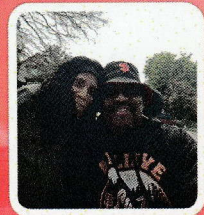
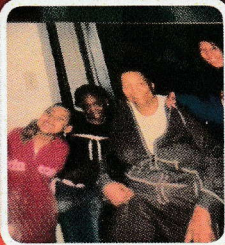
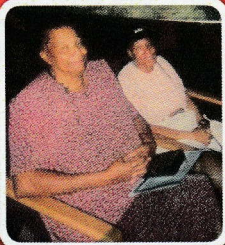
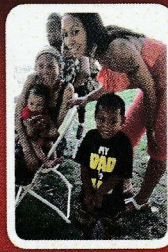
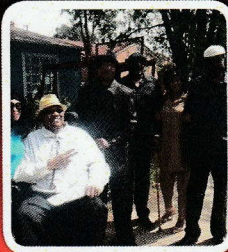
