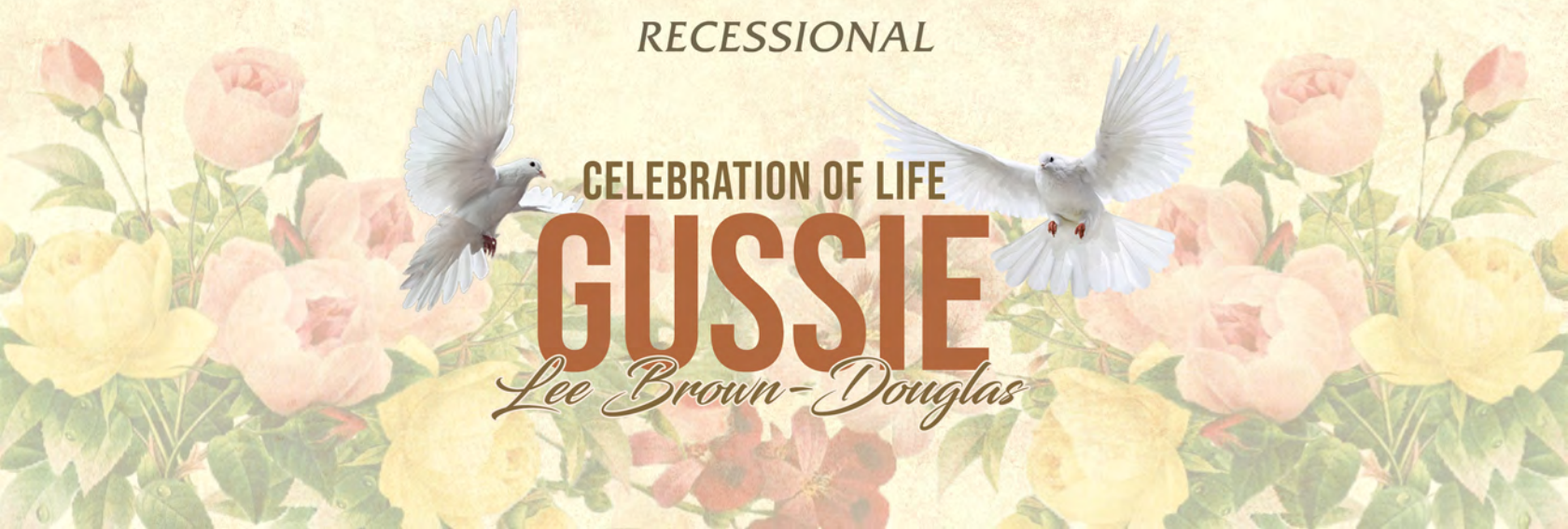

A Beautiful Life

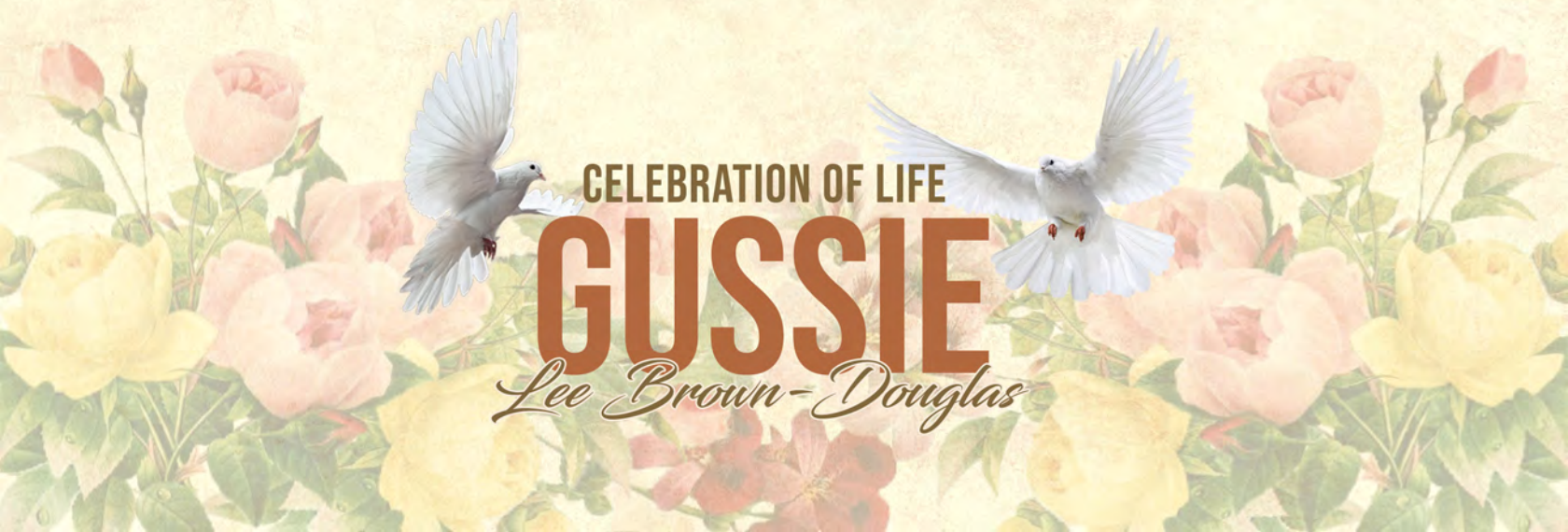

Gussie resided in San Francisco until 2009 when she moved back to Sacramento, CA.

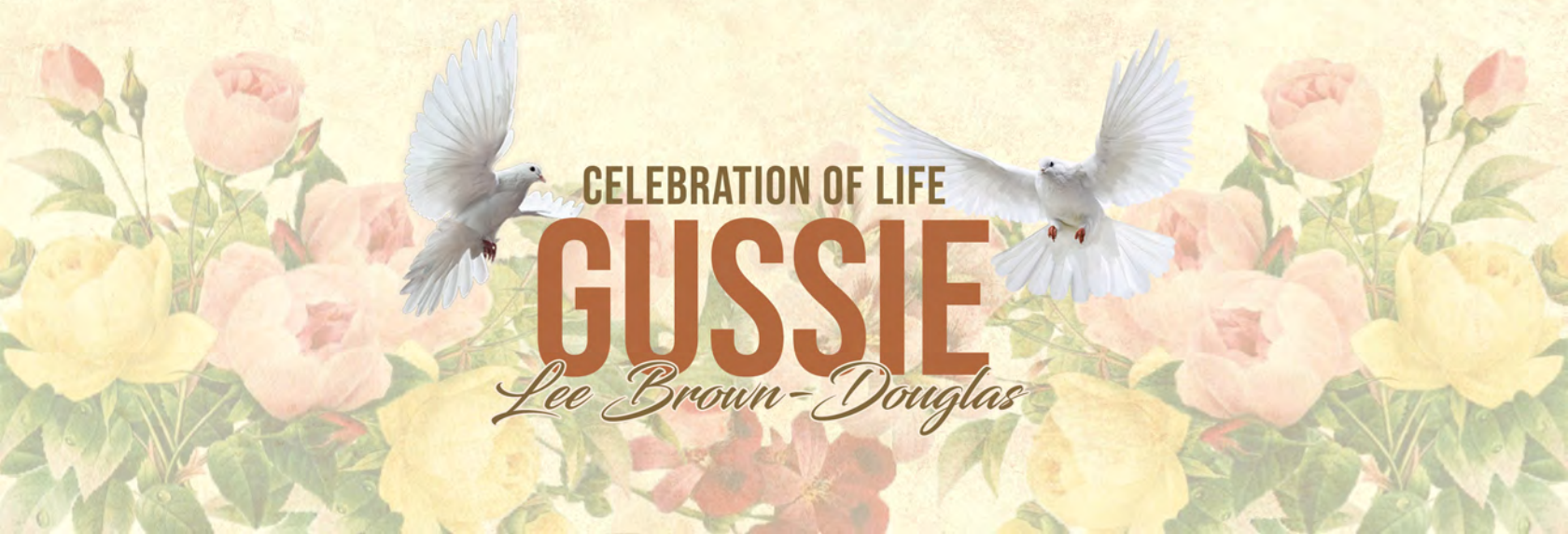


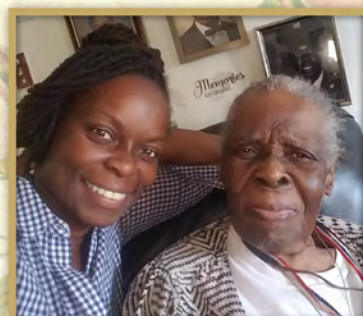
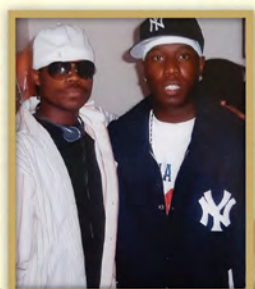
