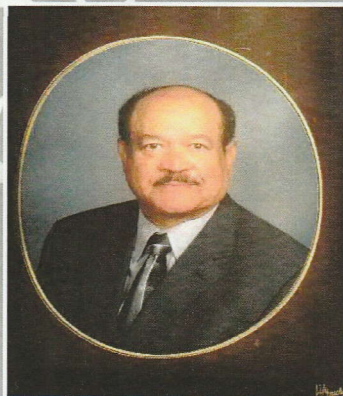

# OBITUARY

Willie Eugene Hunter age 83, passed away peacefully Wednesday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at Mather VA hospital in Sacramento. He was born February 27<sup>th</sup>, 1936, in Hattiesburg Mississippi to Earnest Hunter and Margaret Jordon.

Willie joined the United States Air Force in September 1954 and retired 20 years later in September of 1974. During his 20-year career he served Naha, Okinawa Japan in support of the Vietnam War, four years at Mather AFB, California. He also served at the Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, Colorado; three years at Ramstein Air Base Germany and his final six years of service at McClellan AFB in California where he, Alice, Ricky, Debra and Christy resided in North Highlands until he retired as a Master Sergeant.

After retirement from the Air Force Willie began his career as the Director of Accounting and Finance for Legal Services of Northern California all while continuing his education. He graduated from the University of San Francisco in 1984 with a BS Degree in Economics. He retired in 2004.

Willie enjoyed spending time with his beloved cousins, Curtis and Lovie Perry and the friendships he formed during his military service with Edgar Smith and Jeanette Smith-Jennings. He also enjoyed bowling where he was crowned the California State Champion 1990. He also enjoyed playing golf and listening to Sade.

Willie was preceded in death by his wife, Alice Marie Hunter; brother, Steven; sister, Sharon; and is survived by Barbara, his sister Shirley; his three children Ricky, Debra and Christy and his 11 Grandchildren and 14 Great Grandchildren.
