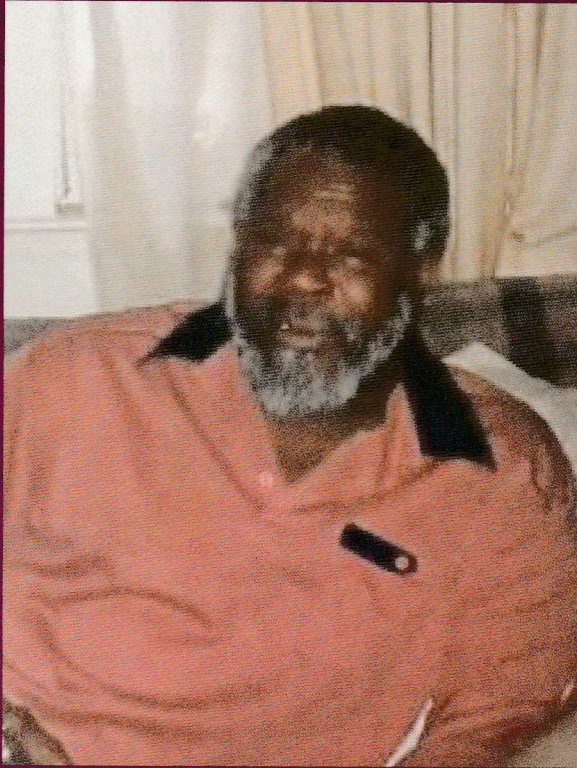

# Obituary

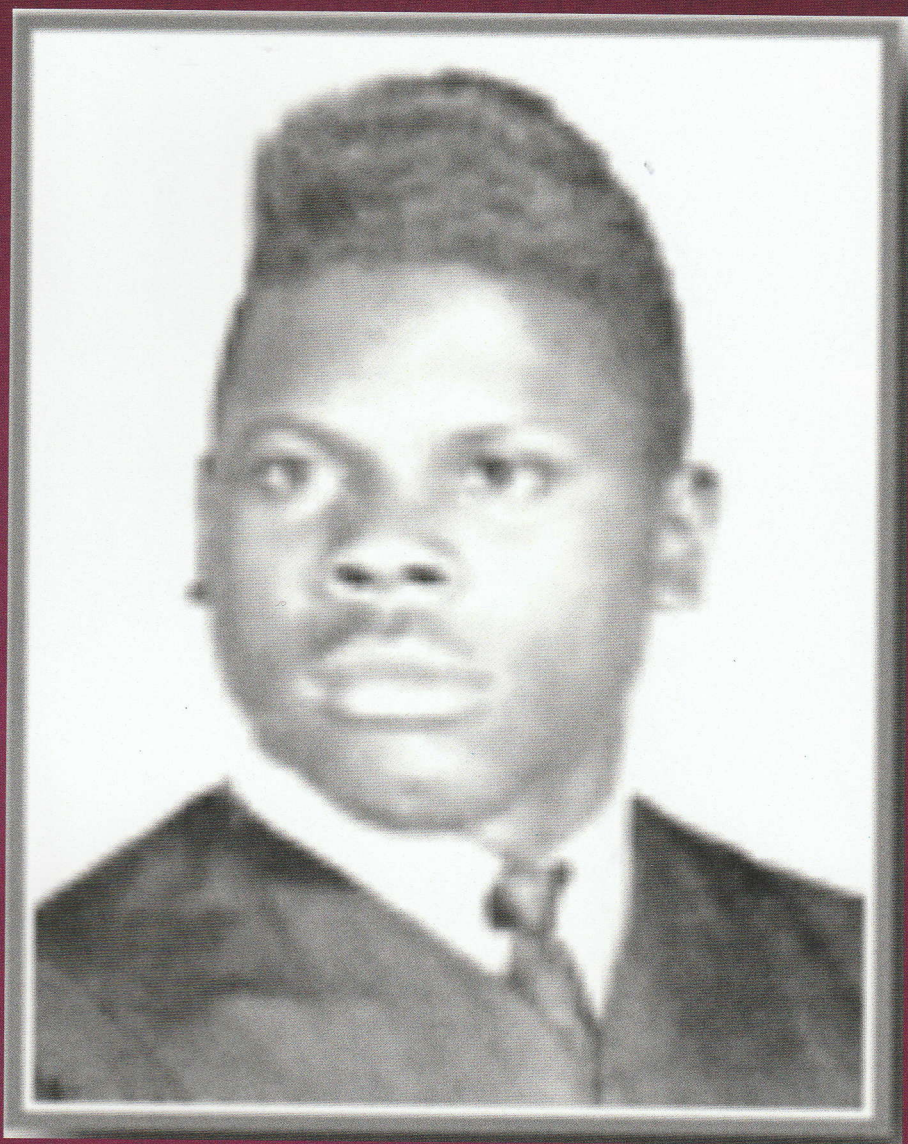

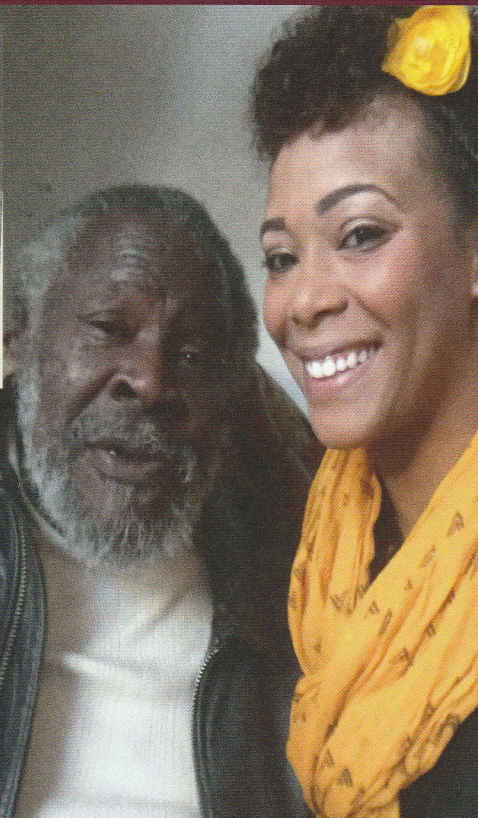














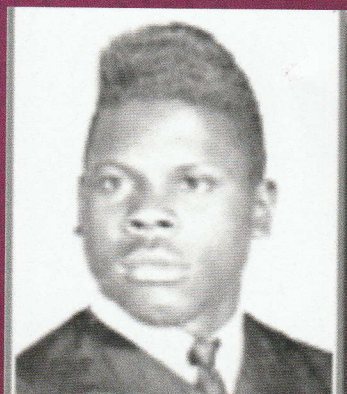
# I Am Free
