


## Close The Gate (For Dad)

Philip Francis "Phil" Eley, of White Plains, GA, passed away Friday, April 7, 2023, working the land on his beloved family farm. He graduated from Greene County High School and attended North Georgia Technical College in Clarksville, GA.
