Belinda Ann Hutcheson Falk of Crawfordville, GA, died on Wednesday, April 4, 2018, at the age of 71. Belinda was born in Jacksonville, FL on September 28, 1946, the daughter of the late Aaron Dupree Hutcheson and Mary Martin Hutcheson. She graduated from Englewood High School in Jacksonville, FL and later attended business school. At the age of 8 she accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior and was baptized at Hogan Baptist Church, Jacksonville, Florida. She was active in church all her life and led ladies Bible study and held several positions as a Sunday school teacher and conference speaker. On July 29, 1971 she married John Denis Falk. After their marriage she assisted him in his law practice and ministry. They resided in Jacksonville, Florida for many years and were members of the First Baptist Church, Downtown, where she interpreted the sermon for the hearing impaired. She was an accomplished seamstress, and was both a pianist and organist and played in the church. Belinda was a member of Crawfordville Baptist Church.
