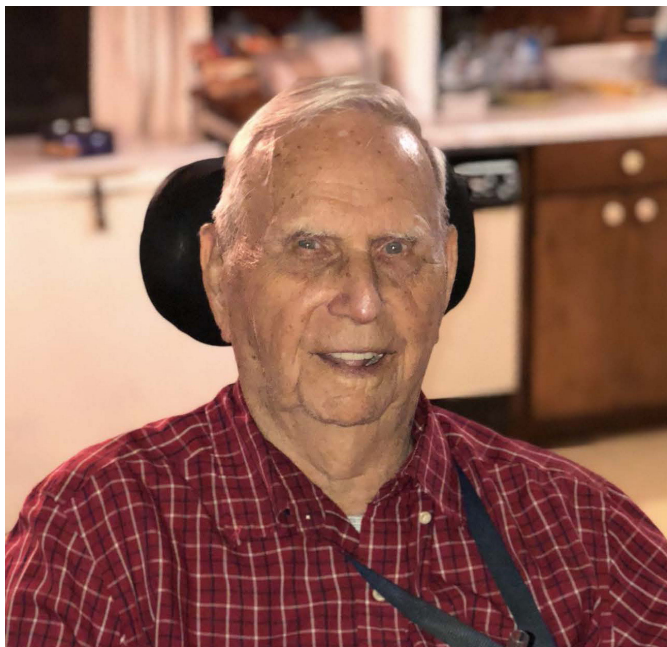

Harold "Boot" Jones entered into rest Saturday, July 28, 2018. He was 90 years old. He was the husband of the late Gwendolyn Wheeler Jones and the son of the late Reuben Henry and Willie Jordan Jones. Mr. Jones was a native of Taliaferro County and served his country in the United States Army spending a year and six months in Japan.
