Paul Deveral Lilly, Sr., age 83, of Greensboro, GA, died on Thursday, May 2, 2019 at St. Mary's Hospital in Athens, GA. Born May 10, 1935 in Louisville, KY, he was the son of the late William Henry Lilly and Isabelle Nora Culmer Lilly. Paul graduated from Charleston High School in Indiana. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army. On June 25, 1966, he married the former Isa Joyce VanMeter of Shelbyville, KY. For many years, he worked for Peter Kiewit Sons, Inc. as the Project Superintendent on heavy highway construction. He moved from Lorton, Virginia to Greensboro in April of 1988. After moving to Greene County, he was the superintendent for the building of Granite Cove. He loved Casino gambling and the race track, especially the Kentucky Derby which he attended many times. Paul was a member of Christ Our King and Savior Catholic Church.
