Leslie Lanier Cowart, age 71, of Madison, Georgia died Friday, November 15, 2019 at Morgan Medical Center in Madison, Georgia. A native of Miami, Florida and born December 17, 1947, he was the son of the late John Moses and Lucille Patrick Cowart. He graduated from Belle Glade High School in Belle Glade, FL and attended Asbury University in Willmore, KY. He married the former Carol Crisler on February 26, 1972. He returned to Madison in 2018 after living in Kentucky close to his daughter. He served as pastor of many churches in the North Georgia and South Georgia Conference of the United Methodist Church. Before retiring he was serving as pastor at the United Methodist Churches in Union Point, Siloam and White Plains. His many interests included photography, music and singing.
