Brenda Cook Williford, age 76, of Greensboro, Georgia, passed away Wednesday, November 11, 2020 at Westbury Rehabilitation Home in Conyers, GA. She was born in Baltimore, MD on May 28, 1944, and was a lifelong resident of Greensboro, GA and then Union Point, GA after her marriage. She was the daughter of the late Lillian Finch Tumlin and stepdaughter of George Tumlin, Sr. both of Greensboro. She attended Greensboro High School. Brenda worked at several jobs before becoming a Certified Medical Assistant.
