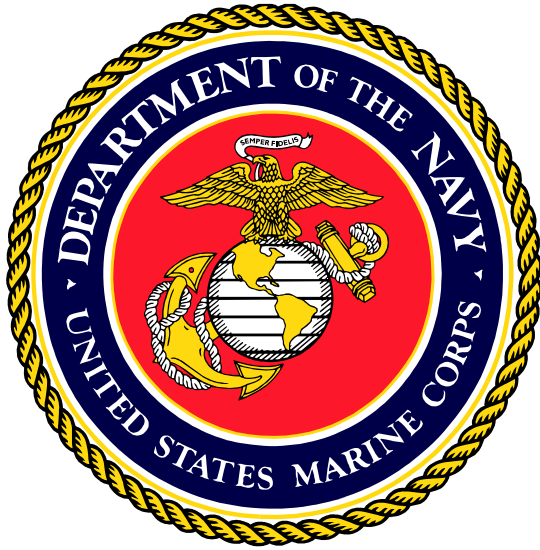

John Lesley Jackson

John Lesley "Jack" Jackson of Union Point, GA, died March 7, 2014 at the age of 74. Born in Ocala, FL on May 5, 1939, he was the son of the late Charles L. Jackson and Lillie Jackson. Jack graduated from high school in Hawaii while in the Marine Corps and began an almost thirty year career with the United States Marine Corps. He proudly served his country during the Vietnam War and Desert Storm and was awarded a number of medals. On March 31, 1990, Jack married Sandra Lee Narsted Incoe and settled in Deltona, Florida. He was the owner and operator of Jackson's Cabinet and Carpentry. Retired, Jack and Sandra moved to Union Point, Georgia, in 2007.
