SIMPLE THINGS

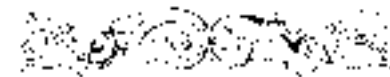
I'm glad that I like simple things –

Sophie Ogletree Drane, age 91, of Union Point, Georgia, died Monday, April 6, 2015 at St. Mary's Good Samaritan Hospital in Greensboro. Born in Union Point on March 27, 1924, she was a daughter of the late Benjamin Addie Ogletree, Sr. and Pearl Jones Ogletree. She was a graduate of Alexander Stephens Institute in Crawfordville, GA graduating as the Valedictorian of the class of 1942. She was a member of the National Beta Club and attended Marsh Business College in Atlanta, GA. She became the Secretary to the Manager of Swift and Company Refinery in Atlanta and worked there until she married Noel A. Drane. They moved to Macon, GA in 1946. Growing up she was a member of Robinson Baptist Church in Robinson, GA, later Cherokee Heights Baptist in Macon, GA and at the present a member of First Baptist Church in Union Point, GA. For 46 years she taught the 4 and 5 year olds in Sunday School. While living in Macon she became the secretary to the Executive Secretary of Pilot Club International and attended one of Pilot Club's Conventions in Chicago.
