Floria Lucile Lankford Epps, age 92, of Greensboro, GA, died Friday, May 5, 2017 at St. Mary's Good Samaritan Hospital in Greensboro. Born in Union Point, GA on May 23, 1924, she was the daughter of the late Carroll Harvey Lankford, Sr. and Floria Burnette Lankford. Most of her life was spent in Bairdstown until she moved to Greensboro to live with her daughter.
