Loyd Vernon Parker, age 85, of Greensboro, Georgia, passed away Saturday, October 16, 2021 at his residence. A native of Greensboro, he was born March 18, 1936 the youngest of twelve children of the late James Elisha Parker and Almedia Hubbard Parker. In 1954 Vernon graduated from Greensboro High School where he was the Salutatorian. During his high school career he was a member of the Beta Club, was the district mile champion in track and played varsity football. On September 7, 1956 he married the former Diane Gillen in Camden County. He served his country in the United States Army receiving an honorable discharge in 1961. He served with the 101st and 11th Airborne Divisions. For a number of years he worked for Irby Thompson as a watchmaker. Vernon was a member of the First Baptist Church of Greensboro and Hamp's Bible Class. He was also a devoted member of the San Marino Lodge No. 34, F & AM in Greensboro, GA where he served as Past Master.
