# Naomi Marchman Credille

Naomi Marchman Credille of Greensboro, GA, died Monday, November 8, 2021. She was 97. Born in Greensboro, Naomi was the daughter of the late Hal Strickland Marchman, Sr. and Flossie Katherine Taylor Marchman. She graduated from Greensboro High school and later took some courses in nursing. Over the years she was a librarian while her husband was station in Charleston, worked for a dentist and kept books for the Greensboro Lumber Company. After returning to Greene County she was the owner and operator of Interstate 5 & 10 from 1974 until 1992. All of her life she was a caregiver and received "Caregiver of the Year Award" being the oldest person still caring for others. As long as her health permitted, Naomi was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church of Greensboro.

She was preceded in death by her husband, William C. Credille, Sr.; daughter, Kathie J. Godbee; brothers, Percy Marchman and Hal Marchman, Jr. sister, Willene Lockery and great grandchild, Chasity Allen.
