Obituary

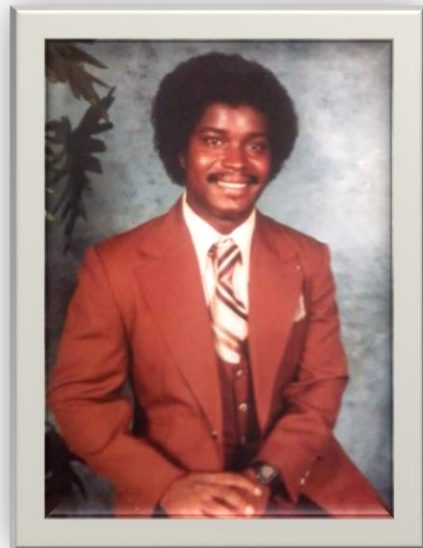
Johnnie Lee Thomas 67 of Liberty Drive Mishawaka IN passed away June 21, 2022.
