

Love's Greatest Gift – Remembrance

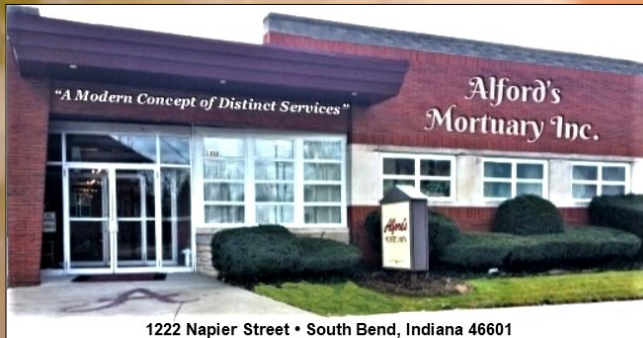
