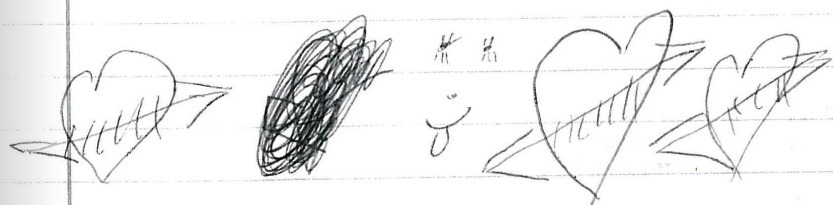


Dear Lisa,

that will NEVER go away

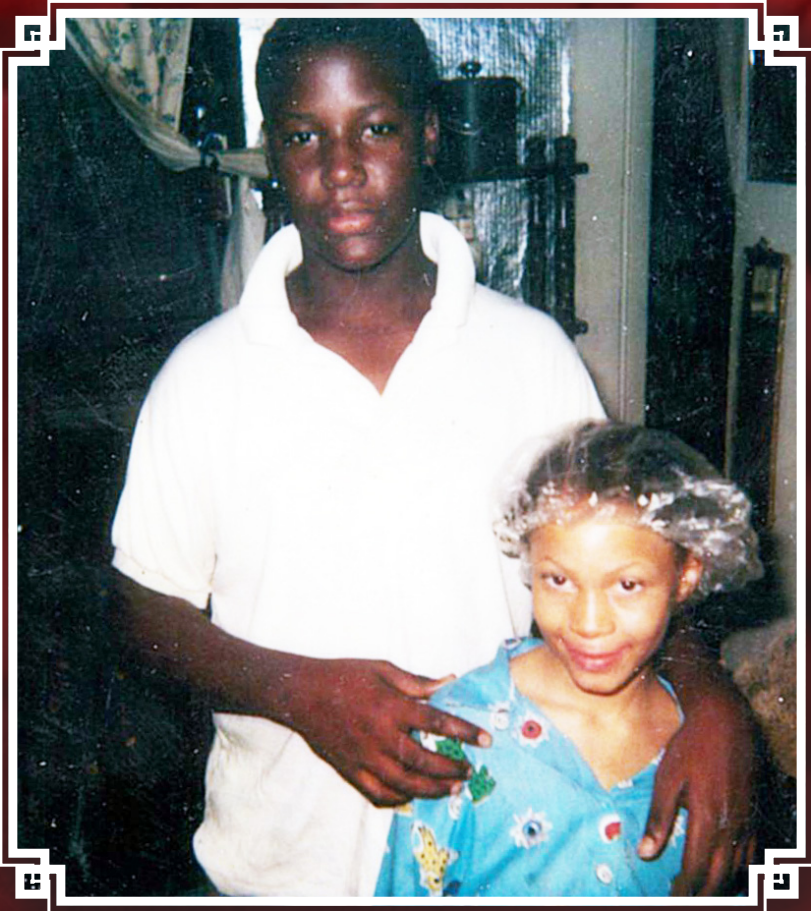
