## Obituary

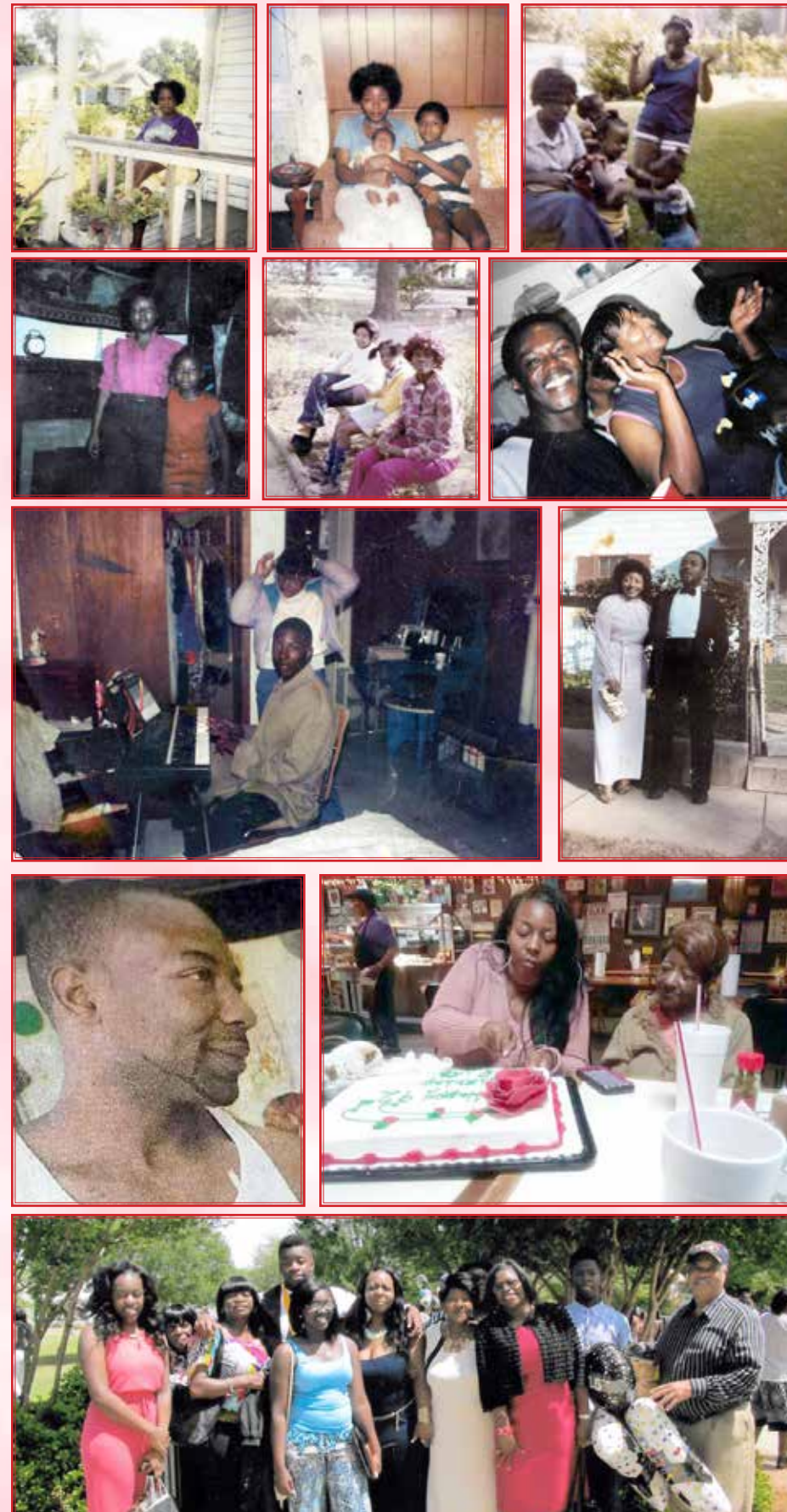
