*When we walk in Heaven on gold.*



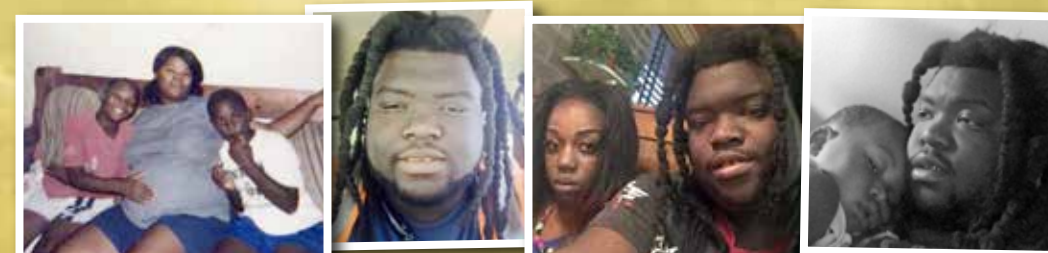
# Justin Jamal Mooney
