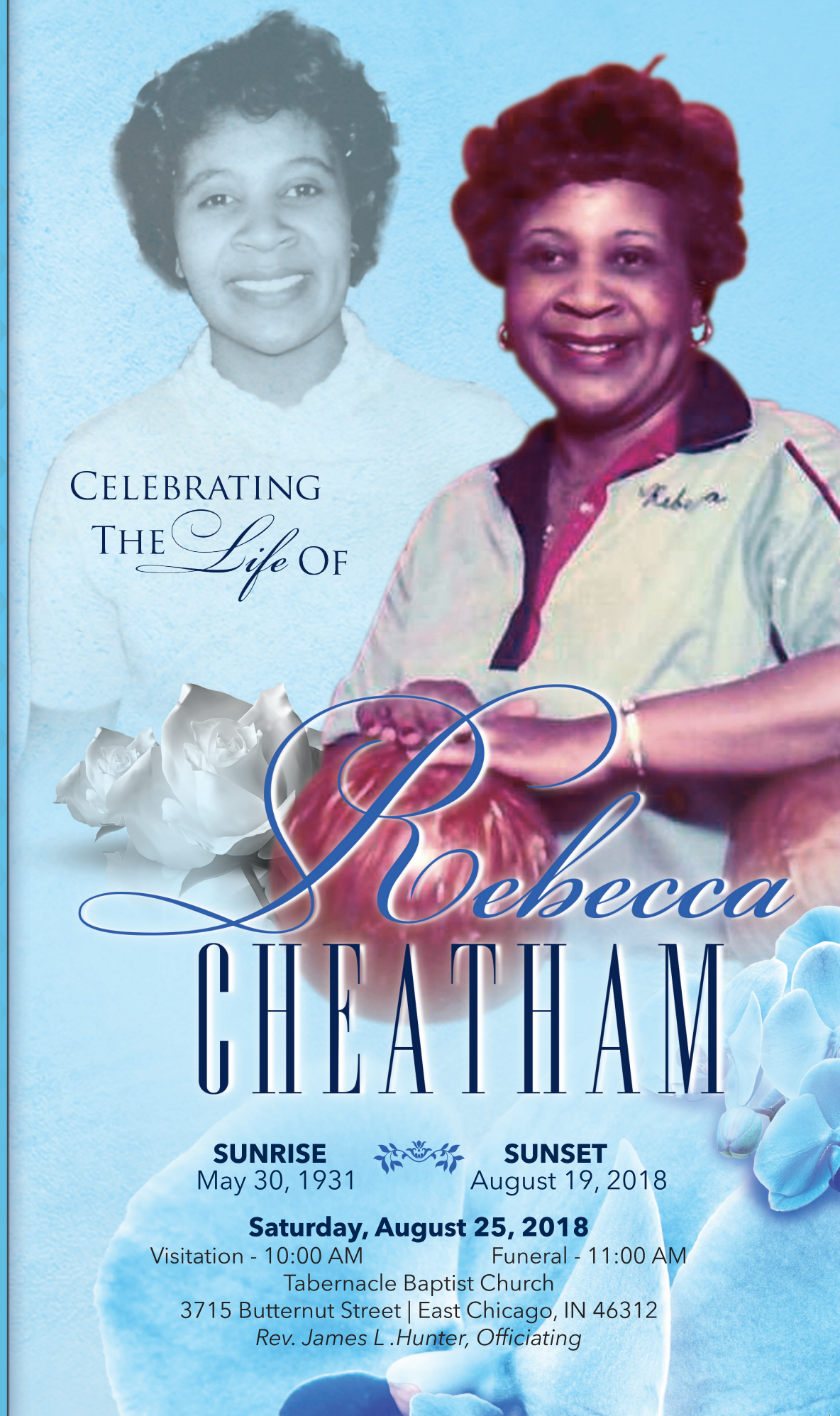

She is preceded in death by her parents and oldest son John Henry Bradley.

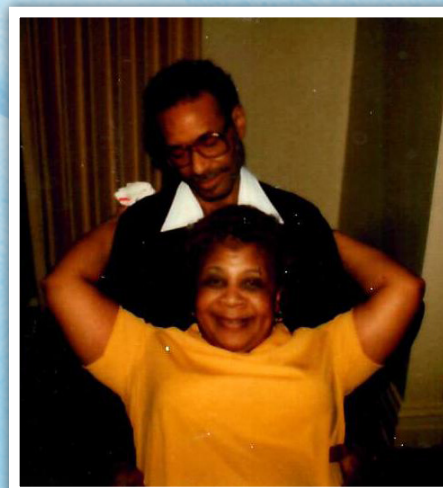
