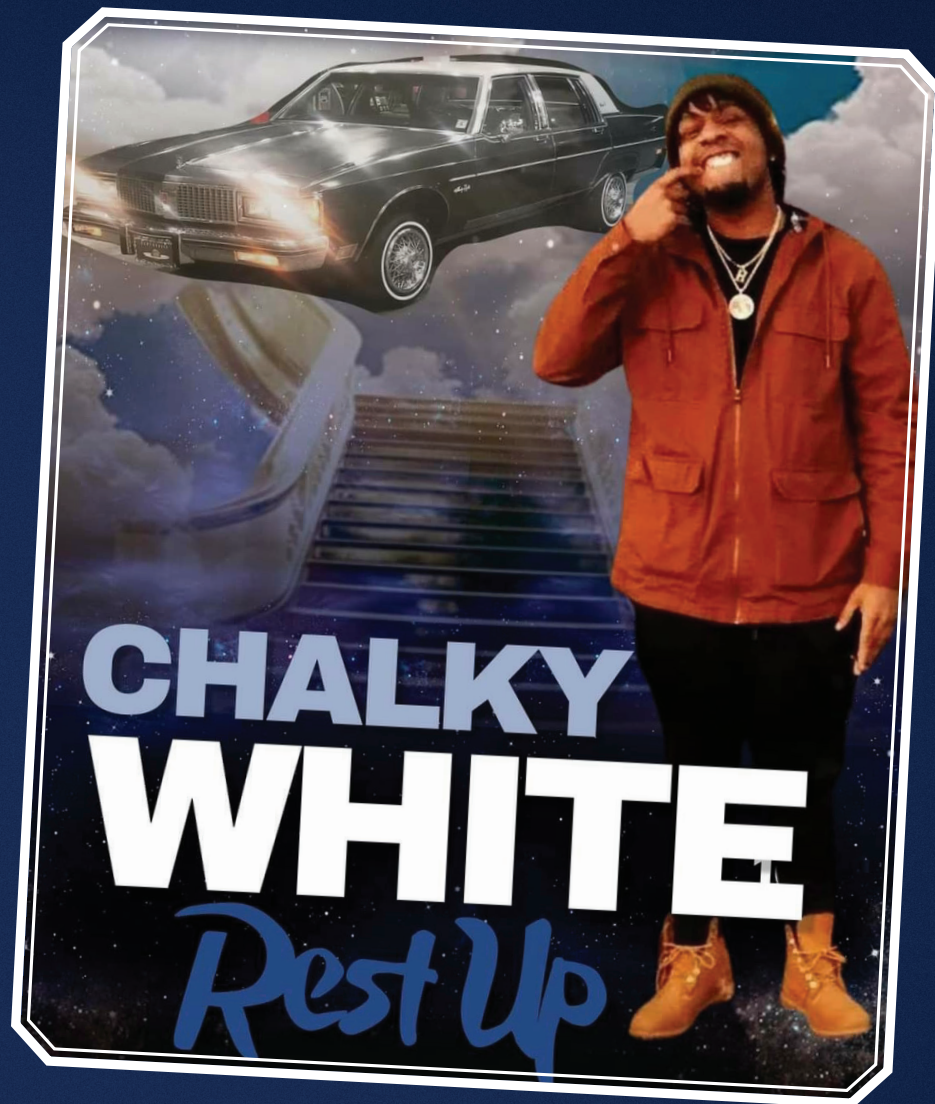
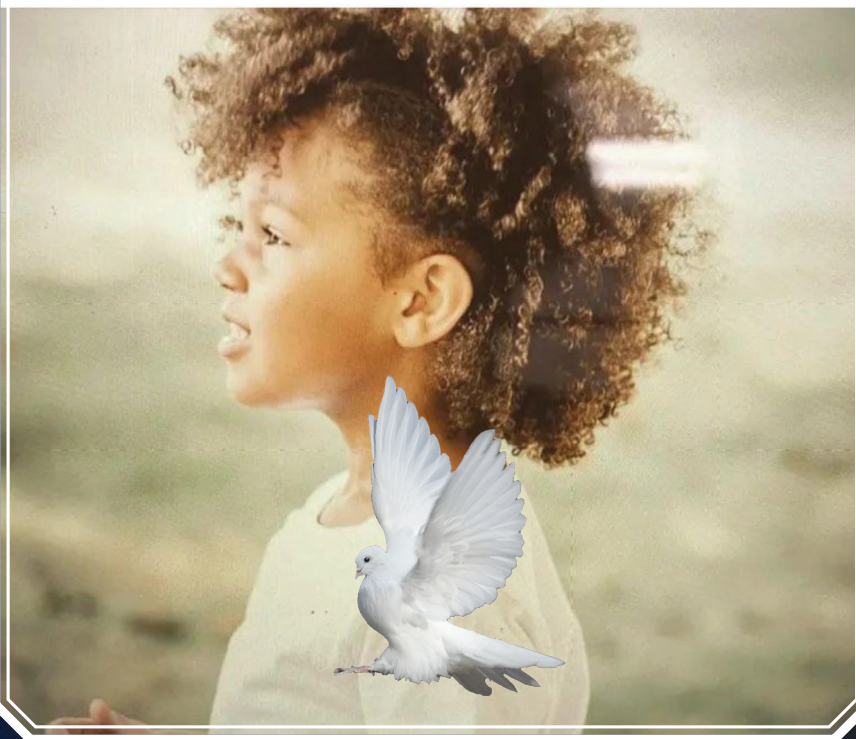

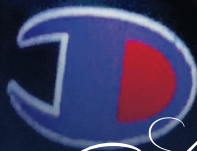
To my Pretty Girl,
