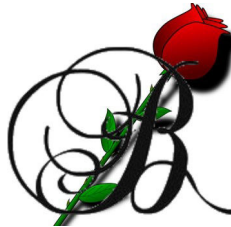

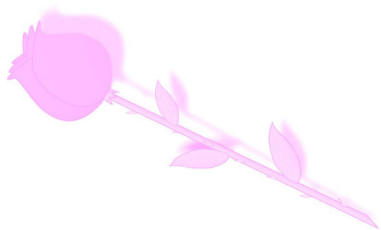
Coco received her education in Darlington County School District. She worked many jobs but the one she's most remembered for is Wendy's of Darlington, SC.
