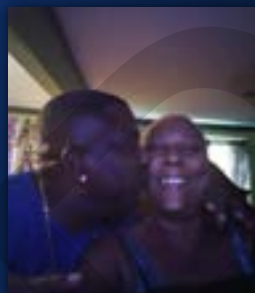


A Letter from Heaven
